FROM YOUR CENTRAL OREGON DIRECTOR WHITNEY BEAVER

Beef Pot Roast Dutch Oven Recipe Ingredients:

3 lb rump roast or pot roast 3 Tbsp vegetable oil 4 potatoes 4 carrots 2 onions 1 tsp salt 1/4 tsp pepper 1/2 cup water Instructions: Peel and slice potatoes. Peel and slice carrots. Peel and slice onions. Pour oil into a dutch oven. Heat the dutch oven to 350 degrees for Frying. Brown roast in oil, turning to brown on all sides. Season with salt and pepper. Add vegetables and water. Cover and Bake at 300 degrees for 3 hours

depending on how well done you like it.



Serves about 8.

This recipe uses a 12-inch dutch oven.

If you have a 10-inch dutch oven, use about 2/3 to 3/4 of the ingredient amounts but keep the temperature and time about the same.

If you have an 8-inch dutch oven, use about 1/2 of the ingredient amounts but keep the temperature and time about the same.

JUICY LUCY VENISON MEATBALLS

INGREDIENTS:

□ 1 POUND VENISON (DEER OR ELK)

□ 2 TABLESPOONS FINELY DICED ONION

□ 1 EGG YOLK

□ 3 TABLESPOONS PANKO BREADCRUMBS

□ 1 TABLESPOON WORCESTERSHIRE SAUCE

□ 2 TABLESPOONS OF YOUR FAVORITE HOT SAUCE (I USE MY HOMEMADE

GREG'S HOT SAUCE)

□ SALT AND PEPPER TO TASTE

□ 4 OUNCES VELVEETA OR CHEDDAR CHEESE, CUT INTO 15 PIECES

□ OPTIONAL GREEN ONIONS FOR GARNISH

SAUCE INGREDIENTS: 1/3 CUP HOT SAUCE AND 2/3 CUP BARBECUE SAUCE

COMBINED

INSTRUCTIONS:

MEATBALLS:

1. PREHEAT OVEN TO 400 DEGREES F. LINE A BAKING SHEET WITH FOIL AND

SPRAY WITH COOKING SPRAY.

2. 2. CUT CHEESE INTO 15 SMALL PIECES

3. COMBINE ONION, EGG YOLK, BREADCRUMBS,

WORCESTERSHIRE SAUCE, HOT

SAUCE AND BARBECUE SAUCE AND SALT & PEPPER. MIX UNTIL WELL

COMBINED. ADD GROUND VENISON AND MIX JUST UNTIL COMBINED.

4. DIVIDE VENISON MIXTURE INTO 15 PIECES. FLATTEN ONE PIECE, ADD A PIECE

OF CHEESE IN THE MIDDLE AND WRAP THE VENISON AROUND THE CHEESE

SEALING IT AS BEST YOU CAN.

5. BAKE 15-18 MINUTES. (DON'T WORRY IF YOU SEE THE CHEESE LEAKING OUT,

THERE WILL BE LOTS MORE INSIDE)!

SAUCE:

1. COMBINE SAUCE INGREDIENTS IN A SAUCE PAN AND BRING TO A BOIL OVER

MEDIUM HEAT. ALLOW TO BOIL 2 MINUTES WHILE STIRRING. ADD IN

MEATBALLS AND TOSS TO COAT. SERVE WARM AND ENJOY!
